Session Highlights

These minutes are of the May 21, 2018 meeting.

There has been a change in the 2018 Ministry Team list-Linda Hood has decided to no longer co-chair the Building and Grounds Committee. Perry Gregory will co-chair the committee with Dr. Warren Thompson. Linda will remain a member of the committee.

A letter was received from the Presbytery of Lake Michigan stating Rev. Dr. John Best will be stepping away from his leadership in the Presbytery at the end of this summer. A Transitional General Presbyter will be hired. Leslie Keusch, Presbytery Communication Coordinator/Office Administrator will also retire at the end of the summer as will Presbytery Treasurer Wayne Komejan. These positions will be replaced.

The session approved a motion from the Building and Grounds Committee to hire John Purchase of Luxury Janitorial to clean, wax and polish the floors in the kitchen, the room off the kitchen, dining room/fellowship hall, both rooms off the dining room, both upstairs bathrooms, the upstairs kitchenette and clean the high traffic carpet areas in the Memorial Room. Cost of \$1,273.51 to be paid from the building maintenance fund.

Judi Emlinger, Co-chairperson of the Christian Education Committee, reported there are seven children interested in going to Camp Greenwood this summer. A motion was approved to use the Shaver Children's Fund to provide camp scholarships to those students. Judi will also put a notice in the church bulletin and newsletter that anyone, who would like to make a contribution towards a scholarship, can do so. Just make sure you state on your contribution it is for camp scholarships. Judi will complete the camp applications and get the required parental permissions.

The Membership and Care Committee has set the date for the annual church picnic at Linda Hood's campgrounds northeast of town. The date is August 19th.

Lavonne Hoover, Chairperson for the Memorial and Investment Committee, reported Kosbar Scholarship applications have been sent to five eligible students.

Lee Hunsberger reported for the Mission Committee. He said for the book and funds collection for the Ionia Head Start students sixty books were collected as well as \$350 for the purchase of books. Our congregation was able to donate enough books for each student to take home two books.

Session passed a motion to pay Dr. Chris Dorn \$150 per Sunday plus mileage effective May 27th.

The pastor search committee continues the search for a part-time pastor. At present, we have no prospective candidates.

The next meeting is July 16, 2018 at 7:00PM.
