Session Highlights

These minutes are of the March 19, 2018 meeting.

The January 24, 2018 death of member #612 Jerrold Satterlee was recorded in the official record book. On January 27, his memorial service was held in the church sanctuary with Dr. Chris Dorn officiating. The funeral committee served a luncheon in the church fellowship hall.

On March 15, 2018 Robert Norman Butler, member #32, died. His death was recorded in the official record book. His funeral service was held March 20th at the Lake Funeral Home in Ionia.

The Declaration of Intent to Support the Mission of the Presbytery, Synod, and PC (USA) was approved by session at the January 15, 2018 meeting. Session approved \$250 for shared mission.

Immediately following the worship service on January 28, 2018, the annual congregational meeting was held. Rev. Ray Kretzschmer moderated the meeting.

During the worship service on February 4, 2018, Rev. David Veldt installed Judi Emlinger, Lee Hunsberger, and Mary Williams as the session members for the Class of 2020.

The Building and Grounds Committee completed the refurbishing of the conference/quilter's room. New ceiling panels were installed, lens on the light fixtures were replaced, new light bulbs were installed and a failed ballast was replaced. The heat radiators were disassembled, cleaned and painted. The walls were also painted. Jan Arnold has offered to pay for new window blinds with rummage sale funds. She is in the selection process.

Our church was invited by North Kent Presbyterian Church in Rockford to join them in a day of sledding and fellowship at Bertha Brock Park in Ionia. This event took place in February and a fun time was had by all.

The Christian Education Committee provided the craft activities for the children at the family nights in February, March and April. The kids really enjoyed making crafts.

Session approved the 2018 budget, which was based on the actual 2017 expenses.

For the safety of our church worshipers as well as our children, session approved locking the east entrance door at the time the worship service begins. Ushers/greeters will be responsible for locking the door. It will be reopened as soon as the worship service is over. The central entrance door will remain open.

The session elected Barbara Klenk and Norma Kilpatrick to be our church treasurers and Margaret Gregory was elected Clerk of Session.

The Mission offering in January was sent to Living Waters of the World. The offering was \$71 and the committee added enough to send \$200. Two Sundays in March food items filled a pew for the IM 3rd Meal program in Ionia.

Session approved music leader, Mike Kauffman's request for 7 Sundays off from April through October. This will be without pay. This is his busy time of the year with his landscaping business.

The pastor search committee continues the search for a part-time pastor.

The next meeting is May 21, 2018 at 7:00PM.
